Did you know that **facepaint** isn't actually paint at all? It's a type of stage makeup specifically designed for skin... the best money can buy! If you want to preserve your beautiful face paint as a memory, it works best to take a photo immediately in full sun or bright light... once you get out from beneath my tent, those colors are really gonna pop!

When you're ready to say goodbye to it, your paint will wash off with a gentle soap or makeup remover. Lather in a gentle, circular motion to loosen the paint and it will come right off. BE CAREFUL around your eyes (especially with little ones) ... there is sunscreen built into the paint, so as useful as it is, it will sting your eyes. As for any **sparkles or glitter**, I do not use adhesive ... these may fall off over the course of the day, or stick with you as long as they like.
